Duty Social Worker's recommendation to Duty Manager	The referral was submitted after nursery reported that Megan, a volunteer had his her own daughter Pippa at nursery in Sept 14. Nursery suggests that they dealt with this.  This relates to another referral that was made for another child whom Megan said that she had gotten angry with and felt like she wanted to hit him.
	Megan is said to handle her children roughly and there is a comment in the referral stating that 'Megan showed no remorse for her thoughts and said she couldn't say she wouldn't hit a child if she became angry with them.' This suggests that Megan is likely to be continuing to use inappropriate physical chastisement with her own children and I would suggest that further assessment is undertaken to ascertain Megan's views towards physical chastisement and to talk with the children to enable them an opportunity for disclosure.
	The information in the referral has been considered alongside the Herefordshire levels of need and response document and meets level 4 Children where physical, sexual or emotional abuse Or neglect is suspected.
	IA to be undertaken to establish Mum's capacity to use appropriate parenting strategies and understand the impacts of physical chastisement. If child discloses physical chastisement, then necessary procedures should be followed.
